

Greetings,

Traditional students are beginning to register for the next academic year and I can now share a **COURSE PREVIEW** with all dual enrollees! Please note that your registration process is different than a traditional campus or online student, so follow the information in this email to apply for your term (or terms) and to request your course registrations via the form I have attached. I can begin collecting the applications and forms now, but registration for dual enrollees will not officially open until April.

The Spring Arbor University **Dual Enrollment application for Fall 2026 & Spring 2027 is now open**: springarbor.edu/apply . **If you already have an application account**: Log back in and select “**Fall 2026**” and “**Dual Enrollment**” as the program. Spring Arbor University will be allowing students to apply for Fall 2026 and Spring 2027 at the same time beginning this year so that you have the option to register for a full academic year. Please note:

In addition to the application, we also require the **Dual Enrollment Registration Request form** signed by the:

- student
- parent/guardian
- school administrator
(if being sponsored by a high school)

First-time dual enrollment students must also submit a current high school transcript to verify eligibility (at least a 3.00 GPA). This may be scanned and emailed to me at heather.greer@arbor.edu .

Course Recommendations

A list of **recommended online courses for Fall 2026 and Spring 2027** is attached. We strongly recommend that students begin with **14-week introductory courses**, as these courses:

- Help fulfill general education requirements
- Transfer more easily between colleges
- Distribute coursework across the full semester

While **7-week accelerated courses** are also available, they require a faster pace and a heavier workload. For this reason, we encourage students to begin with a **14-week course option** before enrolling in accelerated courses.

Please note that students are **not limited to the recommended course list**. If you are interested in other courses or would like to review an advising guide for a specific major, feel free to contact me.
